### **Korean American Community Foundation of San Francisco Announces New Deadline for The Karen Ha Scholarship**

San Mateo, Calif. -- Feb. 28, 2019 -- In consideration of students who are receiving notifications of acceptance in March, the deadline for the scholarship application has been extended to March 17, 2019 12, midnight PST.

The Karen Ha Scholarship was established by the family of Karen Ha to honor her legacy as a founding member and inaugural board co-chair of KACF-SF. Friends and family of Karen donated over \$113,000 to KACF-SF to support under-resourced Korean American students pursuing higher education.

The Foundation will be awarding two scholarships in 2019. Each \$2,500 scholarship will be renewable for the extent of the students' college education, up to four years.

Finalists will be interviewed on the week of April 15 and award notification will be made on April 22. The final two awardee will be announced at the annual KACF-SF Gala on May 4, 2019.
